I estimate the crown was 15-40cm deep and likely ran on the same layer as other recent avalanches in the area."

From email on 01/13: "From Miller Ridge today, I had a brief look into Sheep Creek, and to the mountains south of Cooke City, and observed 7 fresh <u>slab</u> avalanches (that happened in the last 1-3 days). Will send photos of them later if I can get better views.

Most of them were on NEerly aspects, and appeared to be on the new/old Jan. 5th interface. Mid and upper elevations, most commonly in wind loaded terrain. Some propagating a few hundred feet wide. "
